Altec Announces Haiti Relief Efforts

Birmingham, AL, January 15, 2010 – Altec Inc. announced today that it will be contributing equipment and related services to aid in the earthquake recovery efforts in Haiti. Altec plans to send truck mounted aerial lifts and specialty equipment to Haiti to assist in the restoration of critical services including power and communication links.
